Successful completion of the OSSLT is a graduation requirement.

The first round of the online OSSLT is in early November. Results should be available in early January.

Unsuccessful students can try the test again in the spring.

The OSSLT NCVLE is active. Students have access to this resource that contains exemplary work and prep material.

Students will also practice the online version in a 'test run' before the test date to become familiar with test features and expectations.
