

Advanced Preparatory Placement courses are recommended for students who excel academically and who demonstrate a willingness to complete extra rigorous course work.

Note: This is not a course just for a student who gets good grades this is a time committed pathway as the student feels they will excel in university level programming while in high school.

A student's final mark in the course is based on their knowledge of the Ontario curriculum. Evaluation of the AP content occurs during the standardized AP exam in Gr 12 (written annually in May).

Students will earn 5% for successful completion of curriculum extensions in any AP course.

What to think about before you make this pathway choice?

While there are many benefits to taking APP classes in high school, students are reminded not to overextend themselves. Take into consideration the course load and remember that you also need to allow for personal time. APP classes will look good on university applications, but so do extracurricular activities and community involvement.
