What is required to achieve an OSSD

30 credits = 22 compulsory courses and 8 elective credits

- At least one ARTS credit, 1 Gym and one TECH/Senior Science/computer studies/co-op and 1 arts/business/coop/gym/french) See Guidance if any questions
- If you have been at LCHS for four years you successfully complete all 4 religion credits
- If you failed a course or repeat credits
- 40 hours of community service
- **Religion courses & PARTICIPATION in the CEREMONY**
- OSSLT successfully completed or completed OLC40 course
- Ontario Scholar- must have 6 grade 12 courses any level with an overall average of 80%

Community hours

- 159 grads
- 89 students still have not completed all 40 hours
- 44% completion rate
- 9 students have 0 hours (as of February)
- May 17th- due date for hours if attending Prom
- June 3- last date that Guidance will accept hours

Scholarships

- Students who have completed a Financial Form in Google will be considered for LCHS scholarships:
- 1. Application
- 2. Grad committee votes
- 3. Grad list is sent and the sponsor chooses

Valedictorian Selection will begin shortly, the process involves mark calculation, graduate profile, review by principal and voting by the graduating class and grad committee

Valedictorian

Valedictorian: The Valedictorian will deliver the farewell/congratulatory address to the graduating class

Salutatorian: The salutatorian will welcome guests to the Catholic faith-based graduation ceremony on behalf of the graduating class.

All Grade 12 graduating students will be provided with the opportunity to complete and submit the Valedictorian application for review/consideration by the Graduation Committee by April 26th no later than 12:00 p.m

Incomplete or late applications will not be considered.

- Five categories:
- 1. Academic achievement Overall grade point average for Grade 11 and 12 courses only
- 2. School leadership
- 3. Co-instruction involvement
- 4. Community involvement
- 5. Self-reflection Student choice

- **Step One:** Application Review by the Graduation Committee
- Upon review, the Graduation Committee will select no fewer than five, and no more than 10 candidates for peer voting. Confirm that their names will appear on the ballot
- Step Two: Peer Voting
- ► A link to voting ballot will be provided, · Students are to rank their top three choices.
- Step Three: Scoring of the Ballots by the Graduation Committee
- The Graduation Committee will score the eligible ballots and award the candidates with points as follows:
- Three points for a first vote; Two points for a second vote; One point for a third vote
- The candidate receiving the highest overall score will be selected as the Valedictorian and the second highest overall score will be the Salutatorian.
- Must submit a copy of their graduation address to the principal for review at least two weeks prior to the graduation ceremony.

Guidance needs to know

- confirm your offer on-line (all offers are conditional); there are due dates
- attend all orientation sessions as most are mandatory, Student Profile Forms
- -did not receive an offer * wait list, see what programs are still open, may want to consider different start date, alternate offers
- -check school websites for application scholarships/bursaries others will be automatic based on your final average
- -Mid April OCAS and OUAC will receive your midterm marks; if you are taking an on-line/ night course see Mrs. Capretta to make sure it has been inputted on the site
- -July final marks will be sent; if you take Summer courses (your responsibility)
- RETURNING GRADE 12's need to see Guidance then we can choose courses in myBlueprint together
