Why would you want to be an SHSM student?



- obtain a strong foundation for a wide variety of careers in the sector
- customize your education to suit your interests & talents while meeting the requirements for an OSSD
- focus on sector-specific knowledge & skills that are valued by employers & postsecondary educational institutions
- receive an SHSM Record outlining & identifying completion of the required components, including certifications, training programs & sector-specific credits achieved
- receive an OSSD with the Red SHSM Seal identifying the completed components





How is it recognized?



- An Ontario Secondary School Diploma with an embossed red seal.
 - An SHSM Record documenting achievements.
 - Formal recognition the Ontario Student Transcript.

Certain post secondary institutions have bursary or scholarship opportunities for SHSM students for example: Brock University, Guelph-Humber and Niagara College.





What are the required components

- 1. A bundle of <u>nine</u> grade 11 and grade 12 courses including:
 - Four 'major' credits in the sector specific courses
 - <u>Three</u> 'supporting' credits in English, Math, Science, Religion or Social Science (CLA- contextualized learning activity required for each of these)
 - <u>Two</u> cooperative education credits tied to the sector

2. Sector recognized certifications (ie. CPR, First Aid, WHMIS)
